Fleas and Plague - Extension

at the turn of the century, plague has been a persistent concern in California, Arizona, Colorado and New Mexico. In the 43 year period between 1957 and 1999, there were 45 confirmed plague cases originating in Colorado, of which nine resulted in death. Plague can infect all rodents. Cats are also very susceptible. Dogs can become infected.
